CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU CAMP PAYMENT AGREEMENT

CAMP FEES - **One-time payment for Registration and T-Shirt & pants** - \$50 (\$40 if your child has a Gi pants currently).

Deposit to hold your child's spot - \$50 for each camp your child will attend. (The balance of the camp fee will be billed on the Thursday before the camp session that your child will attend.)

Multiple Child Discount:

For families with more than one child enrolled in Camp, there will be a \$20 per session discount per child after the enrollment of the 1st child.

Carlos Machado Jiu-Jitsu Member/Non-Member Fees

To receive Carlos Machado member rate, campers(s) must be a current member of Carlos Machado Jiu-Jitsu at the time of registration and their membership must be current on the date of the session they are registering for. Refunds **WILL NOT** be granted if camper(s) become members after time of registration.

CAMP REFUNDS

Full refunds will be granted when requested <u>at least</u> five (5) business days prior to the session start date, **less** the \$25 registration payment. Refunds requested less than five (5) business days prior to the start of camp, or after the session has started will not be granted. Failure to attend a registered camp session will be considered a forfeiture of all fees paid.

Payments will be accepted until 8:00 pm on the Thursday before the start of a camp session. No payments will be accepted the following morning if a waiting list exists.

After the payment deadline, if a waiting list exists, all unpaid registrants will be dropped from the camp and space will be offered to those on the waiting list. **No deposits will be refunded or transferred.**

Wait List

There is no fee to be placed on the wait list. If a spot becomes available, the camper(s) parent/guardian that is prioritized at the top of the wait list (prioritized according to the date and time of the received required registration forms) will be contacted via telephone and email. The parent/guardian will have 24 hours from the time of notification to make full payment for the desired camp session. If payment is not received within 24 hours, the camper(s) parent/guardian next on the wait list will be contacted.

Illness

If your child becomes ill and cannot attend camp, you must notify Carlos Machado Jiu-Jitsu within 24 hours and provide an original doctor's note dated the first day your child was out of camp or before in order to receive a prorated refund. Doctor's notes may not be faxed and require an original signature or stamp

The very nature of Mixed Martial Arts/Grappling is hazardous and risky, including, but not limited to acts of sparring, competing, instructor demonstration/instruction, unsportsmanlike conduct, lack of or incorrect technique, failure to wear protective equipment, recklessness, loss of control, inadequate supervision or instruction, lack of physical conditioning, mismatch of opponent's size, strength or skill, poor warm-up, equipment failure, poor officiating, premises defects, and all other circumstances inherent to the sport of martial arts. Carlos Machado Jiu-Jitsu & MAAC Student Discipline Policy

The Carlos Machado Jiu-Jitsu & MAAC was founded on the principals of discipline, respect and self-control. Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu is the vehicle used to install each of these character qualities into our students. Alas, there are times when a student may not adhere to the code of conduct required at the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC and disciplinary measures must be taken.

Discipline, according to Merriam-Webster Dictionary, is training that corrects, molds, or perfects the mental faculties or moral character.

The CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC firmly believes that discipline is learned through example, participation,

and instruction and at times, disciplinary action. We strive to teach all students to respect themselves, their family and friends, and those of authority. The last is especially important for students to learn.

The goal of the MMC is to teach by example and instruction, but at times, students must be shown that there are consequences for disruptive behavior, disrespect of authority, and volatile/violent outbursts.

Following in the tradition of many decades of martial arts training the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC uses various methods of disciplinary instruction.

Rules are set forth; children are given the rules of conduct in each class and know what is expected of them at all times. If a child needs reprimand, he or she is first told to stop what they are doing, and then asked why they are not following the rules. Depending upon the offense, they are either given a second chance or further action is taken. The next step is to separate them from the other kids in a place of personal reflection to let them cool down and think about how they might behave differently.

If this has been done, or the offense is egregious, the child will be asked to perform a basic martial art exercise such as, but not limited to, wall sits, push-ups, jumping jacks, squat kicks, or some similar activity. If this is proven to be ineffective, or the child responds to the instructor in an inappropriate, disrespectful or volatile/violent manner, further action is required.

As a martial arts school, the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC employs various Martial Arts principles of

discipline. Sparring of the students is used in instruction as well as correction. The sparring of a student may be conducted by an instructor or another student of equal or higher rank as the offending student. Control is used at all times by both instructors and students, with safety equipment such as head gears worn. This disciplinary action may be conducted either in front of other students or with only the student, instructor and at least one other witness present, either a MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC employee or student.

If all of the afore mentioned methods have taken place and the student is still not complying with the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC's

Code of conduct, Michael Madeley/Evan Thompson is called in to administer further corrective action. This can be either a sparring session or a parent meeting in which the offense will be discussed and action on the part of the parent is expected. If a student is consistently noncompliant to the rules, the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC reserves the right to refuse service to the child for a set period of time as in a suspension, or to terminate the care indefinitely.

Dear CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC Parents,

The 2021-22 school year is off to a great start!! We are enjoying the new children in our care as well as those that have been with us for years. In order to run the most efficient after school martial arts program possible, we need your help in a few matters. The following items are some issues we are having. Please read through them carefully and pay close attention to the new late pick-up fee and No Call no show fees.

No Class List & Early Pick-ups

It is extremely important for all students to finish class each day, it is the time we instill discipline, respect, and self-control through the learning of martial arts. For this reason, we ask that if you need to pick your children up before the end of class, please place them on the "No Class List." This will ensure no disruptions to the class. If they are not on the "No Class List" and held out of class, Michael Madeley/Evan Thompson reserves the right to hold them in class until it ends.

Late Pick-up Fees

It is extremely important, for both children and staff, that parents are on time picking up children from CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC Attack/SSC.

- After 6:30pm a \$20.00 fee per child in care for the first 15 minutes, and \$5 per minute thereafter will be added to your bill. Example: 2 kids are picked up at 6:47. The charge would be \$60.00. This payment is due at the time of pickup, or before the children are picked up from School/ dropped off at the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC the next day. Children will not be allowed back at the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC until this fee is paid.
- If an emergency occurs and you anticipate that you will be late picking up your child, please make arrangements for one of the authorized individuals on your child's emergency information form to pick up your child at the designated pick up time, 6:00.
- If your child is picked up late (after 6:30) more than three times during the school year or during Summer Camps, services for your child may be terminated.

You will be contacted via telephone call and notification in the Parental Note basket after the third offense with a notice that any further occurrence may result in immediate removal from the program.

No Call/No Show Fee

This fee is in regard to the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC After -school Program. A child is considered a "No Call/No Show" if the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC has shown up at the school to pick up the child and they are not there without prior notification to the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC. A family is allowed two (2) No Call/No Shows per year free of charge. Every No Call/No Show after that incurs a \$12.00 fee per incident. CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC reserves the right to terminate pick-up services or care altogether if No Call/No Shows occur on a consistent basis.

CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC AFTER SCHOOL/SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM

ATTENTION PARENTS:

- Parents/guardians MUST sign children out DAILY on the "Sign In/Sign Out" Form on the front counter. Parents on CCS MUST scan card daily AND sign children out daily on the "Sign In/Sign Out" Form on the front counter.
- If your child does not need to be picked up(for example due to illness or other absence from school), you MUST call the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC (214-494-6111) at least one hour prior to their pick-up time to have them put on the "No Pick-up List." If the CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC shows up at your child's school, and your child is not there and we have not received a call, it is called a "No Call/No Show" and you will be charged \$12.00.
- All payments MUST be made the Thursday prior to the week of care. If payment is not made, the CARLOS MACHADO
 JIU-JITSU & MAAC WILL NOT pick up your child the following Monday.
- The CARLOS MACHADO JIU-JITSU & MAAC front office will no longer hold money for children's snacks. Parents
 must either send snacks daily or send money for snacks daily. Also, due to space constraints, the MACHADO JIU-JITSU &
 MAAC cannot hold a week's worth of snacks for children.

MUST HAVE'S

Each child attending the after school program must have the following items:

• Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu uniform or appropriate athletic clothes.

HELPFUL TIPS

- LABEL EVERYTHING!!! Please label every item such as clothing, lunch boxes, water bottles, blankets, etc. with your child's name. Because the children change clothes, we end up with a VERY LARGE lost and found box. It is easier for kids to keep up with their personal belongings when they have their name on it.
- The **White Board** over the front desk will have important information regarding upcoming events such as field trips and daily theme activities. PLEASE ALWAYS READ THIS BOARD!!!
- We ask that no foods requiring refrigeration and/or heating in the microwave be sent for snacks. We do not have the facilities to refrigerate and heat food for each child.
- PLEASE DO NOT SEND ANY SNACKS OR MEALS CONTAINING PEANUTS or PEANUT PRODUCTS. We have children with a peanut allergy, and we are trying to be as accommodating as possible for his/her health.
